Homosexuals - 1

You are friends of the person in the story. You meet and talk about it:

What do you feel?

What are you afraid of?

What do you consider to do now?

Try to make the audience understand the situation without reading the full text.

Homosexuals - 2

You are ordinary people sitting in a Berlin café. On the front page in the newspaper on your table there's a story about a Gestapo raid on a club known as a meeting-place for homosexuals. About 20 where arrested, the place is shut down.

Over coffee and cake you talk about the incident.

What do you think?

What do you say?

Do you all have the same opinion? Do you argue?

Anna W. - 1

You are the professional committee of the Assen welfare department. You have to issue a recommendation regarding Anna W., who is about to turn 21 and then will no longer be under your responsibility.

There are two options:

- a) you recommend Anna be recognized as a healthy adult, capable of an independent life.
- b) Anna cannot function independently and you recommend hospitalization in a psychiatric institution.

Try to make the audience understand the situation without reading the full text.

Anna W. – 2

This is a meeting of the psychiatric committee with Anna, where Anna is notified of the decision to sterilize her.

One of you is Anna, the rest – the committee.

Committee: Is it important for you to persuade her that you are right? What do you say to her? How does her reaction affect you?

Anna: what is your reaction to their decision? What do you say to them? What is your goal in this meeting?

Present the situation in the street with minimum explanations.

What does each of them feel in that encounter?

What does each of them actually do?

Dinner at the former-secretary's family. She tells about the encounter in the morning. What are the reactions around the table?

What do you feel about what happened?

What do you propose to do now?

Do you all think the same?
What do you say to each other?
